**SOLDIERS WAR 1812**

**From old Town of Genoa, which includes some men from the present  
Town of Lansing.**

ARMSTRONG, (Captain) WILLIAM,  
Town of Genoa, cemetery unknown.  
Died of wounds received at  
Sacketts Harbor.

BLOOM, CHARLES, Town of Lansing.

BLOOM, (General) HENRY, Town of  
Lansing.

HAGIN, CHARLES, Town of Lansing.

LABARRE, EPHRAIM, Town of  
Lansing.

LEAVENWORTH, (Captain) JOHN, Town  
of Genoa, Cemetery unknown. Came  
from Watertown, Connecticut in  
1809. Resided on Lot #29. Kept a  
tavern and small store in part of  
the building. He was commissioned  
as Lieutenant by Governor Daniel  
D. Thompson in Colonel John  
Harris's Regiment and went with  
the company to frontier at  
Lewiston in the War of 1812.  
Later became Captain under Lt.  
Col. Mathew N. Tillotson.

McGUIGAN, CHARLES, Town of Genoa,  
Belltown Cemetery. On stone in  
cemetery back of Methodist  
Church. Died 12/16/1882 at the  
age of 97. Soldier of War of 1812  
and son of Michael McGuigan a  
soldier and officer in the  
Revolutionary War. Erected by his  
granddaughter, Minerva P.  
Chamberlain and nephew Charles  
Hall.

MINIER, (Major General) DANIEL,  
Town of Lansing.

NORTH (Captain) JOSEPH, Town of  
Lansing.

SHAW, ROBERT J. Town of Lansing.

THORPE, (Colonel) DANIEL, Town of  
Genoa, Genoa Cemetery. Born 1778,  
died 3/15/1837 at the age of 59  
years and 11 months.

TICHENOR, CABEB, Town of Lansing.

TILLOTSON, (Brigadier General)  
JOHN, Served in the Revolutionary  
War and the War of 1812. (See
